Topics Included in Course:

- Understand literary themes, symbolism, point of view, conflict, imagery, allusion and rhetorical devices.
- Use of Classic Literature and Historical Reading Selections to discuss and write about themes of culture, sin, forgiveness, love, justice, personal and governmental responsibility, and equality and their relevance to the lives we lead as Christians.
- Develop usage of rhetorical devices (repetition, parallelism, hyperbole, juxtaposition, etc.) in writing.
- Research writing skills (MLA documentation, annotation, summarization, paraphrase, complex thesis statements, outlines, argument and counterargument, and sentence, paragraph and essay structure.
- Write well-crafted persuasive thesis essays with narrative, descriptive, expository, and comparative elements.
- Effectively presenting material with the use of technology
- ACT/SAT vocabulary skills (Greek and Latin roots)
- Essay Test Taking skills

Students can expect to spend an average of 1 1/2 hours a day on homework.

Supplies:

- Access to a dictionary and thesaurus and to a library and computer for extensive research
