Textbook: None required. (The tutor may take some lessons from Drawing Textbook by Bruce McIntyre.)

Course Description This class will concentrate on sharpening drawing skills and helping students develop their own style of drawing. We will be building on skills acquired in Drawing I and learning more advanced techniques. The drawing class will include (but not be limited to) the following techniques:

- Drawing with pencil, charcoal & conte crayon
- Shading techniques
- Outdoor sketching
- Pen & ink techniques
- Markers

- Colored pencils
- Pastels
- Watercolor/acrylic paints
- Portraiture
- Illustration

We will be learning about famous artists and illustrators as part of class. Students will have brief drawing homework assignments each week.
