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Overview of LATIN STUDIES II (Grades 7-12)

Supplies: All Latin students should bring the following to class:

- Writing Utensils
- Paper
- Required Text
- Students may need index cards to make flashcards in class or at home

Course Description: This course is designed for middle or high school students who have completed Intro to Latin/Latin I and wish to continue their Latin studies. The students will continue where they left off in Intro. to Latin/Latin I.

The study of Latin has a strong emphasis on grammar and English derivatives, so this class can be used as one full year of foreign language credit, or ½ year English; ½ year foreign language credit. Coursework will involve reading, writing, conversation, memorization, grammar, history and culture, and literature analysis. The in-class overview of Roman history will continue from where the Intro to Latin/Latin I class left off.
