Course Description: This course is designed for middle or high school students who have completed Latin III (or its equivalency) and wish to continue their Latin studies. The students will continue where they left off in Latin III; however, the tutor will assess each student's level at the beginning of the year and modify/adjust lesson plans accordingly.

The study of Latin has a strong emphasis on grammar and English derivatives, so this class can be used as one full year of foreign language credit, or ½ year English; ½ year foreign language credit. Coursework will involve reading, writing, conversation, memorization, grammar, history and culture, and literature analysis.
