Texts and Literature Selection Required:

- *Themes in Literature, 5th Edition* — Abeka - Code Number: 341932
- *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe* by C.S. Lewis
- *Romeo and Juliet* by William Shakespeare (side-by-side version or a copy with footnotes that explain some language, culture, etc...may be helpful but not required)
- *The Pearl* by John Steinbeck
- *A Christmas Carol* by Charles Dickens

Class Description: Using the Abeka textbook as a guide, this course will focus on recognizing and appreciating the elements of great literature. Works by a wide variety of master writers will be examined and analyzed by the class. A large focus of this class will be recognizing the literary elements of plot, theme, style, characterization and setting; and learning to compose a literary analysis according to these criteria. We also cover research and research paper writing, essay-writing techniques and creative composition. Students will be taught how to improve their own writing skills through the revision process and should plan to spend at least an hour per day on homework for this class.
